

Announcing Escort Program Transit Service to Raymond

The Madera County Public Works/Transit Department, in cooperation with the Community Action Partnership of Madera County/CAPMC and the Raymond Community Association, is pleased to announce new Eastern Madera County Escort Program transit service to residents of Raymond on Wednesdays *effective September 6, 2017*.

The Escort Program is a demand-response, general public service for transporting residents in Eastern Madera County for medical appointments in Madera, Fresno, and Clovis. Madera County contracts with the CAPMC to operate this service.



The Escort Program is operated with a five-seat van equipped with a wheelchair lift. Service to Raymond will be provided on Wednesdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for medical-related appointments within the

Escort service area. Morning medical appointments are encouraged to ensure all passengers can be accommodated with minimum wait and ride times to and from appointments.

Pick-ups and drop-offs will be at the Raymond General Store located at 32196 Road 600. No service is provided on Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Trips can be scheduled by calling 559-658-5555 at least 24 hours in advance. The fare is \$10 round trip. No application for service is needed. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult. Escort also serves residents of North Fork, Bass Lake, Oakhurst, Ahwahnee and Coarsegold on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
