

## **Notice of Intention to Adopt a Negative Declaration/Notice of Availability**

**Notice is Hereby Given:** Madera County Transportation Commission (MCTC) is the lead agency on the below-described project and has prepared a Negative Declaration on the proposed adoption of the Madera County Active Transportation Plan (Project) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). MCTC has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment and therefore the Negative Declaration was prepared. The complete Project description, location and the potential environmental effects are contained in the Negative Declaration.

**Project Title:** Negative Declaration for the Madera County Active Transportation Plan (ATP)

**Project Location:** The various components/improvements recommended by the ATP are located throughout Madera County.

**Project Description:** The proposed project under CEQA is the adoption of the Madera County Transportation Commission Active Transportation Plan. The ATP itself contains various programs, policies, and recommendations pertaining to the development of pedestrian and bicycle facilities in Madera County. Specific development is not being proposed under this ATP and adoption of the Negative Declaration would not authorize any development. The ATP is intended as a guidance document with the ultimate vision of trails, walkways, and bikeways that provide safe, convenient, and enjoyable connections to key destinations around the County.

**Document Availability and Public Review Timeline:** MCTC invites the public and agencies to provide comments on the Project. Due to the time limits mandated by State law, your response to the Negative Declaration must be sent at the earliest possible date *but not later than 30 days* after receipt of this notice. The review period for the Negative Declaration will be from April 11, 2018 to May 11, 2018.
