On behalf of California Trucking Association (CTA) I am writing to express strong support for the Madera County Transportation Commission's regionally significant project currently under consideration for the Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) grant program.

The CTA is the nation's largest statewide trade association representing the trucking industry. Established in 1934, our 1,400+ members represent all segments of the industry, including both small and mid-sized family owned companies headquartered in California as well as large logistics providers in the Fortune 1000.

California Trucking Association fully supports the Madera County Transportation Commission (MCTC) BUILD grant application for the California State Route 99 – Avenue 12 to Avenue 17 in Madera County – widen from 4-6 lanes project. Federal funding for this project will assist in enhancing a vital passenger and freight traffic corridor through California.

State Road 99 (SR 99) serves as the backbone of the Central Valley's agriculture economy. Identified in the California Freight Plan, this project will strengthen major goods and people movement section of SR 99 through the City of Madera.
