Measure T Annual Work Program

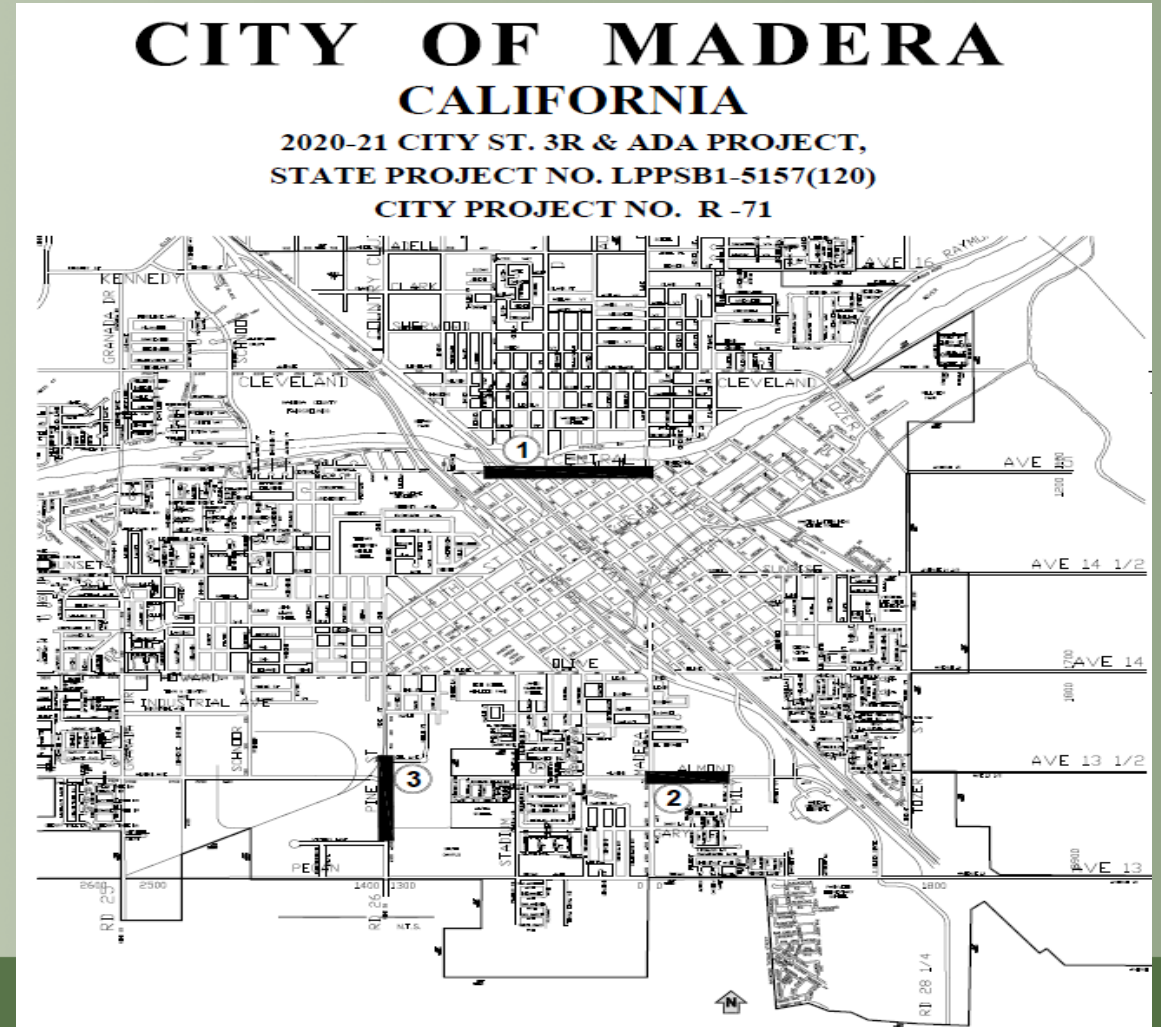
Introduction

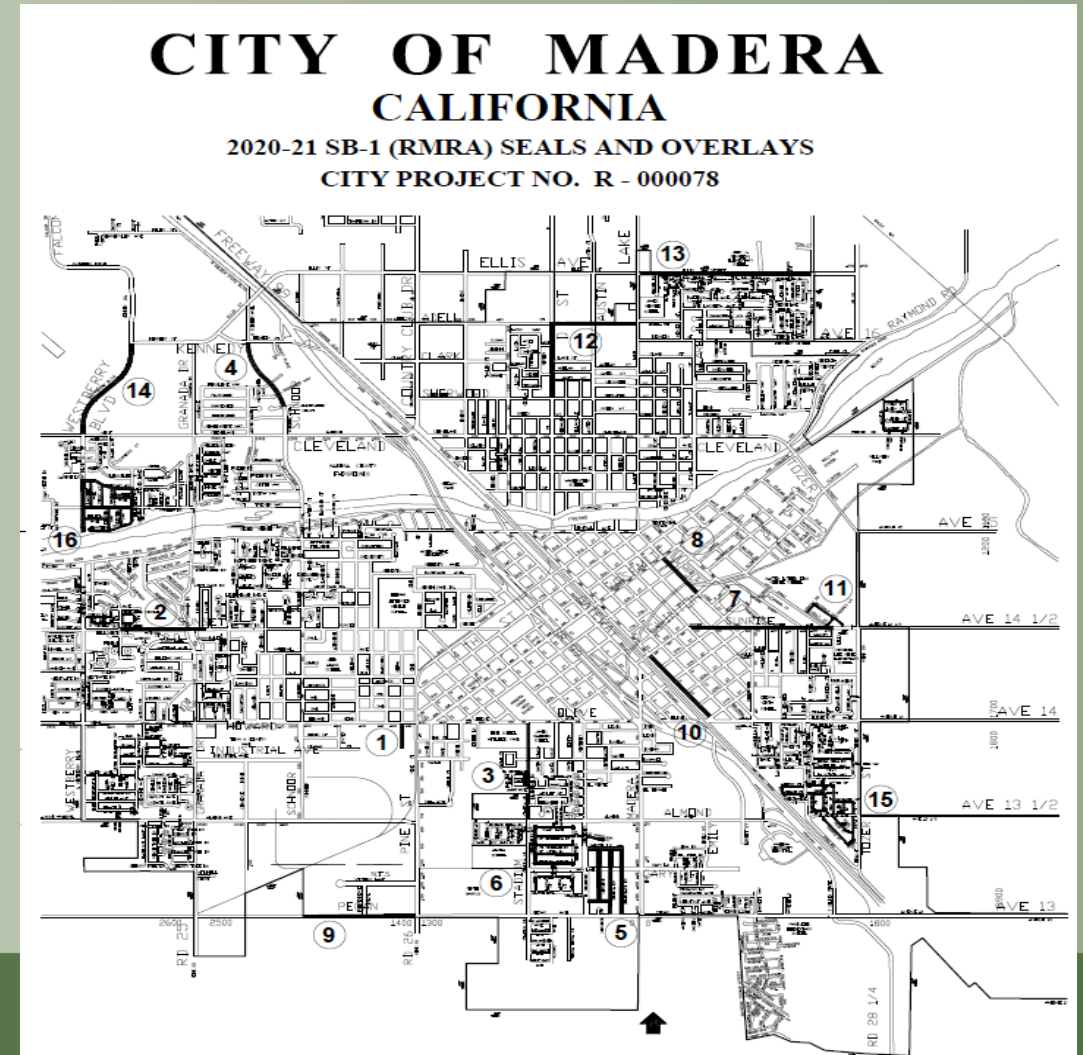
R-71 2020-21 City Streets 3R & ADA Project

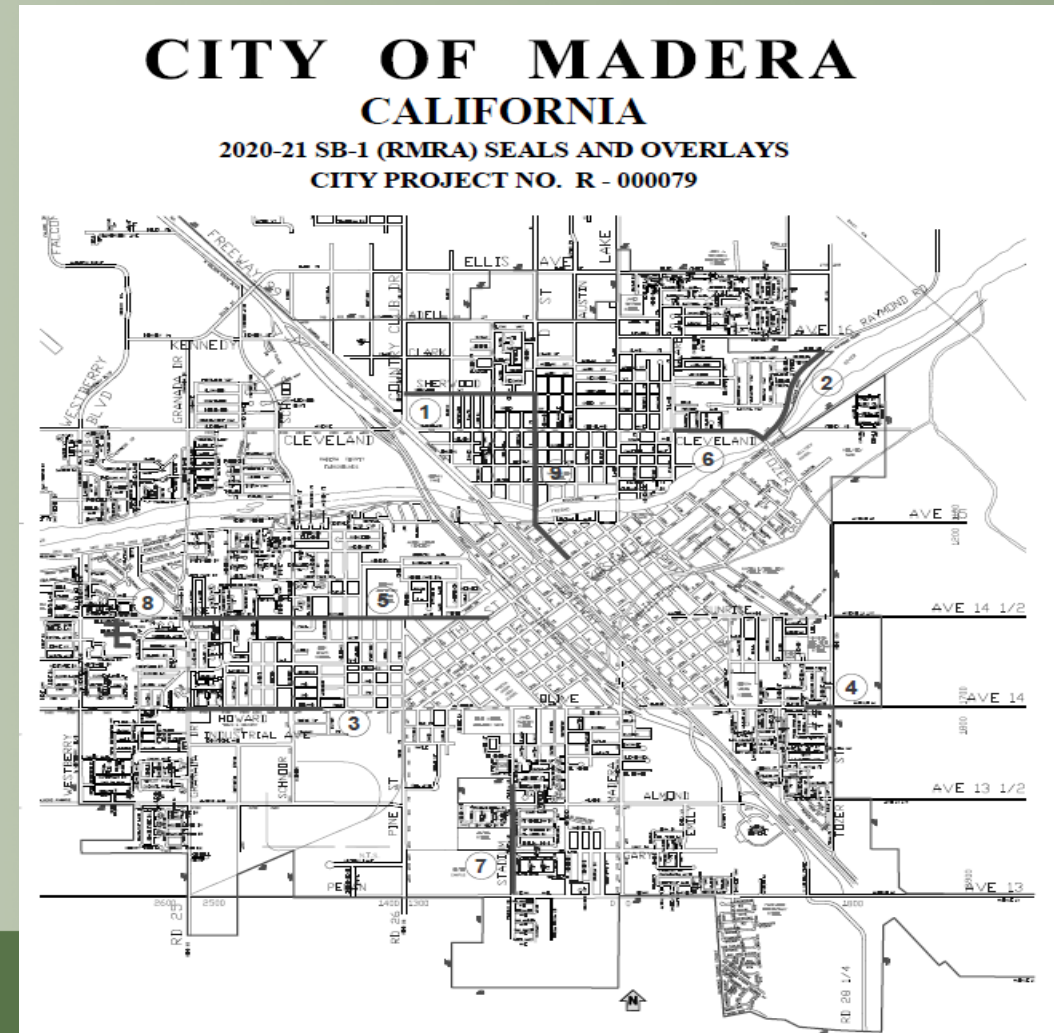
R-78 – RMRA Seals/Overlays 2020-21

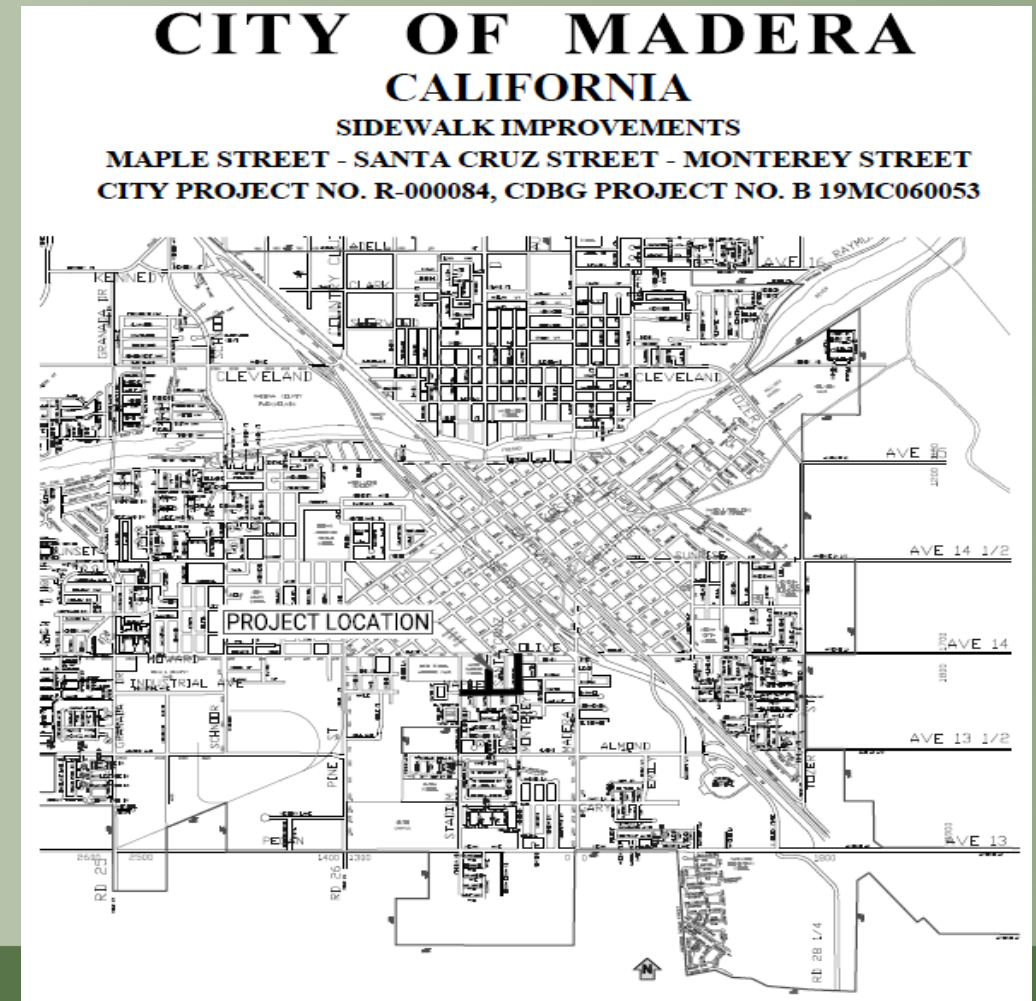
R-79 RMRA Seals/Overlays 2021-22

2022-23 Work Plan

Safe Routes to School & Jobs

29.79% of the City's Measure T Funds

- Street Maintenance & Supplemental Street Maintenance Program (29.79%) ~ \$1.5 million
 - Included in Annual Budget for pothole patching , crack filling, various pavement seals and other street department maintenance
- ADA Compliance (0.5%)
 - Provides funding to enhance sidewalk project budgets to install curb access ramps and ADA compliance projects

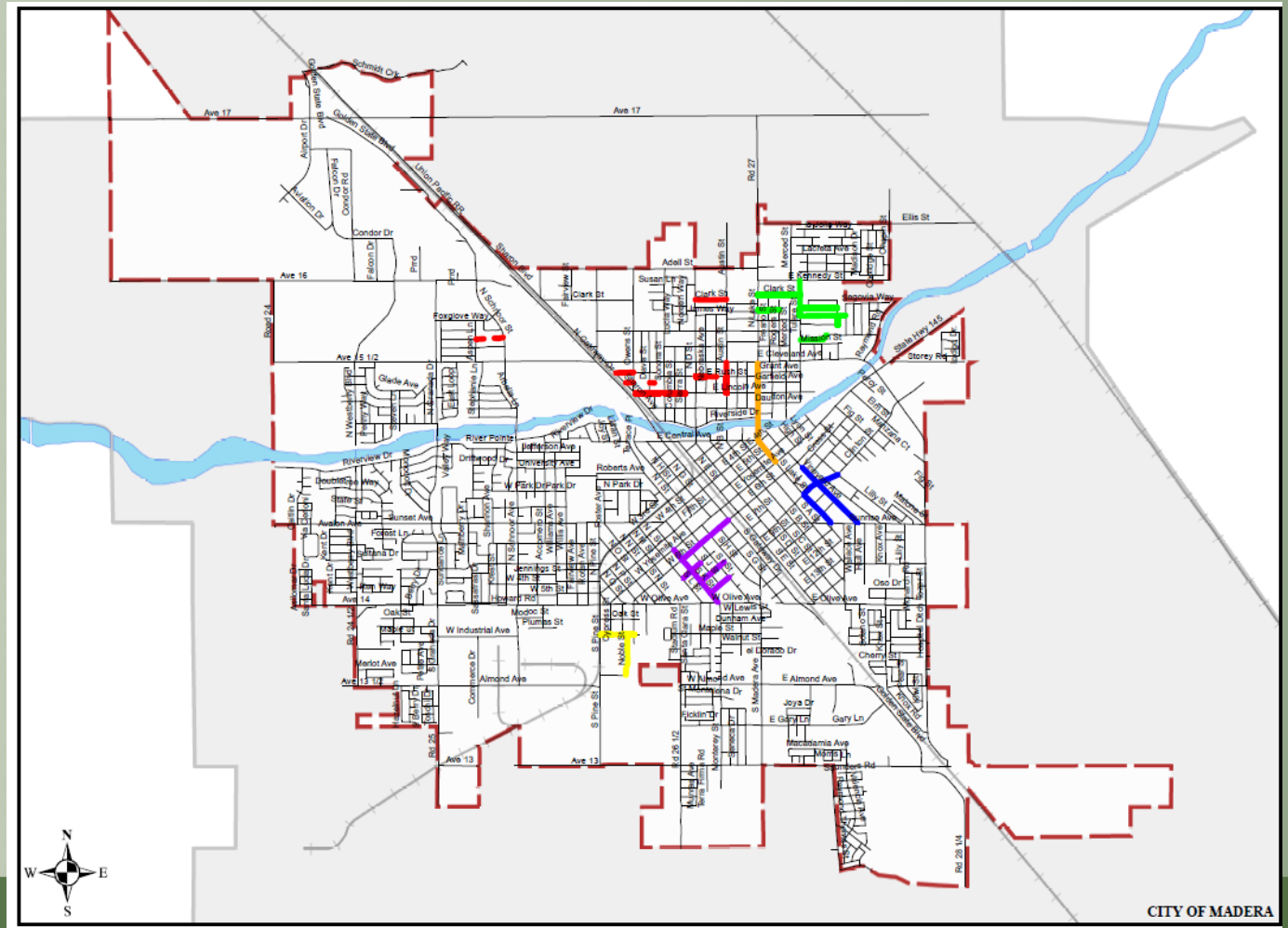
R-10 – Olive Avenue Widening, Gateway Ave to Knox Ave

Projects in Development Phase

- Almond Avenue Connection between Pine Street and Stadium Road
- Includes traffic study of Almond Avenue, Stadium Road and Pine Street Corridors

Transit Enhancement

2% of the City's Measure T Funds

- Prior Allocation on New Transit Facility
- Current Allocations are Reserved for Future Projects/Enhancements



Environmental Enhancement

2% of the City's Measure T Funds

- Alley Paving Various Locations (match CMAQ grant)
- Various Sidewalk Projects
 - Schnoor Sidewalks (match CMAQ grant)
 - Washington School (match CMAQ grant)
- Bicycle facilities (match programmed CMAQ grant)
